

Scenario	Expected Triage Urgency Category
1. Aminah	TRIAGE CODE D Rationale <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Requires specialist MH assessment (prevent potential mental deterioration)</li> <li>• Patient/carer distress</li> <li>• Not suicidal</li> </ul>
2. Joseph	TRIAGE CODE C Rationale <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Requires specialist MH assessment</li> <li>• High risk group for suicide (age/gender)</li> <li>• Depressed with suicidal thoughts but no clear plan or intent</li> <li>• No previous suicide attempts</li> </ul>
3. Ishani	TRIAGE CODE F Rationale <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mild MH problem</li> <li>• Does not require specialist MH assessment</li> <li>• Other services more appropriate</li> </ul>
4. Margaret	TRIAGE CODE E Rationale <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Requires specialist MH assessment</li> <li>• Non-acute onset (unlikely to be delirium)</li> <li>• In a safe environment in the wait period</li> </ul>
5. Unknown young male	TRIAGE CODE B Rationale <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Requires specialist MH assessment</li> <li>• High risk behavior associated with perceptual disorder/thought disturbance</li> <li>• No know history of aggression/not currently aggressive</li> </ul>
6. Mihala	TRIAGE CODE A Rationale <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Overdose – requires immediate medical attention</li> <li>• Emergency services – ambulance</li> </ul>
7. Ali	TRIAGE CODE G Rationale <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not requires specialist MH assessment</li> <li>• Request for information only</li> </ul>
